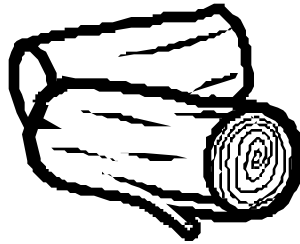
Class will be held *today* in the Dogwood Room during the sermonette time.

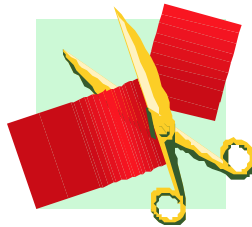
Work Progress
